The Eswatini Communications Commission (ESCCOM) seeks to recruit well-rounded individuals to undertake an intensive two-year structured Graduate Trainee Program in the Technical Services Directorate:

I. GRADUATE TRAINEE - BROADCASTING SERVICES

Reporting to the Manager Broadcasting Services.

JOB PURPOSE:

To provide the requisite technical support in broadcasting matters and assist in the monitoring of compliance and enforcement of broadcasting license conditions including regulations, standards, codes, guidelines, etc.

PRIMARY TASKS/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. To carry out service coverage and broadcasting compliance monitoring leading to the assessment of compliance of broadcasters in line with legislation, license conditions and broadcasting standards;
- 2. To conduct and report on broadcasting station inspections to ensure compliance with legislation, license conditions and broadcasting standards;
- 3. To carry out quality of service measurements leading to the assessment of compliance of broadcasters, content providers and signal distributors in line with the Quality-of-Service framework as set by the Commission:
- 4. To coordinate data collection on activities related to Radio and TV programming, audience profile, penetration of services and network coverage;
- 5. To ensure that all technical terms and conditions stated in broadcasting and radio licenses are complied with by broadcasting licensees;
- 6. To prepare statements and compile evidence for enforcement of actions under the legislations governed by the Commission;
- 7. To offer support to the Standards Committee which is responsible for drawing up and reviewing a code of ethics and practices;
- 8. To continuously carry-out research and developments in the broadcasting sector regulation, licensing, and advice management on trends;
- 9. To carry out any other job-related tasks as may be assigned by the supervisor.
