



## **GENERAL NOTICE NO. 10, 2018**

### **PROPOSED DECISION IN TERMS OF SECTION 32 OF THE SWAZILAND COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION ACT, 2013: BAND PLAN FOR TERRESTRIAL FIXED SERVICES BANDS FOR CONSULTATION INVITATION FOR WRITTEN REPRESENTATIONS**

The Eswatini Communications Commission, hereinafter referred to as the Commission, has developed a band plan for Fixed Terrestrial Services in accordance with Section 34 of the Electronic Communications Act, 2013 and authorized by Regulation 5 of the Electronic Communications (Radio Communications and Frequency Spectrum) Regulations, 2016. Regulation 5 provides that the National Frequency Allocation Plan falls under the Radio Frequency Plan and shall be detailed and provide a description of how a band is allocated.

The Terrestrial Fixed Services band plan gives detailed frequency channelling arrangements and also specifies detailed allocation of the radio frequency spectrum in the Fixed Services bands (2GHz, 4GHz, 5GHz, Lower 6GHz, Upper 6GHz, 7GHz, Lower 8GHz, Upper 8GHz, 10.5GHz, 11GHz, 13GHz, 15GHz, 18GHz, 23GHz, 26GHz, 28GHz, 32GHz and 38GHz) which have been made available for use.

The provisions of Section 32 of the SCCOM Act, 2013, allow for stakeholders and interested persons to make comments on proposed decisions of the Commission. The public is hereby invited to submit their written presentations on the proposed Decision to publish the Band plan for Fixed Terrestrial Services published herewith by the Commission.
